

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Children and teenagers 5-19 years old who have arm weakness from a stroke are potentially eligible.

WHAT THERAPY IS BEING OFFERED?

Transcranial Direct Current Stimulation, a form of brain stimulation, is being tested in conjunction with conventional occupational therapy for arm weakness.

Patients will receive 2 hours of therapy per day for 5 consecutive days if they choose to participate in the study.

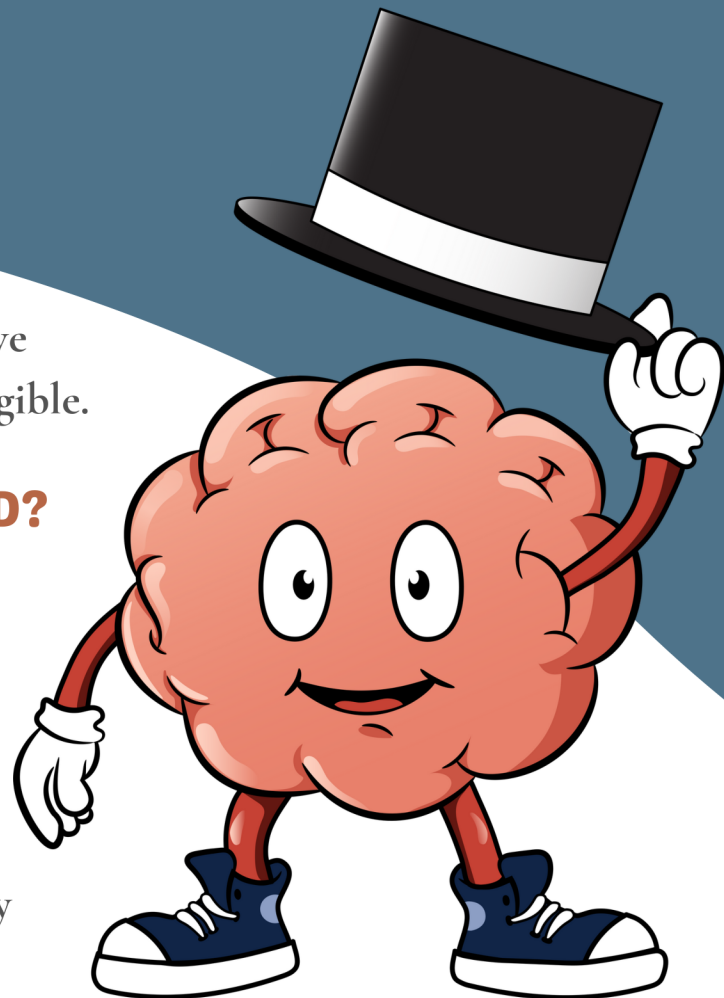
